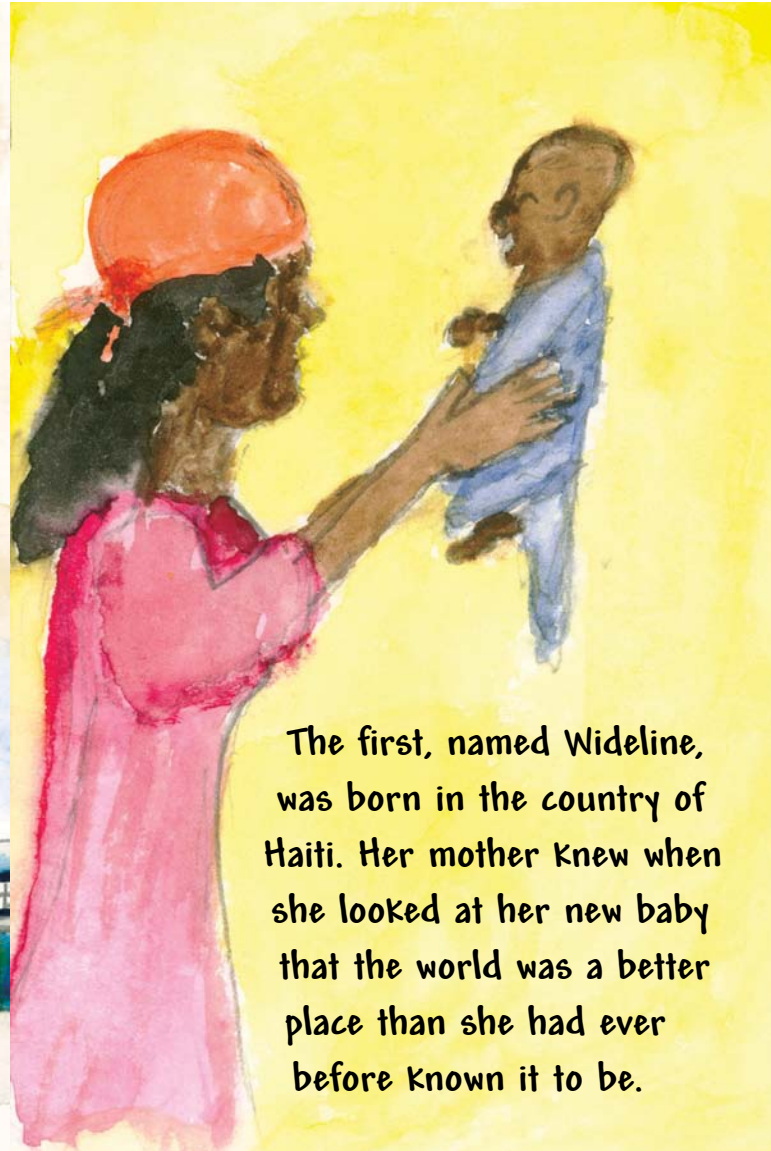


For Wideline, my sister

The second, named Jillian, was born in the United States of America. Her parents could only think of God when they looked at their new baby.

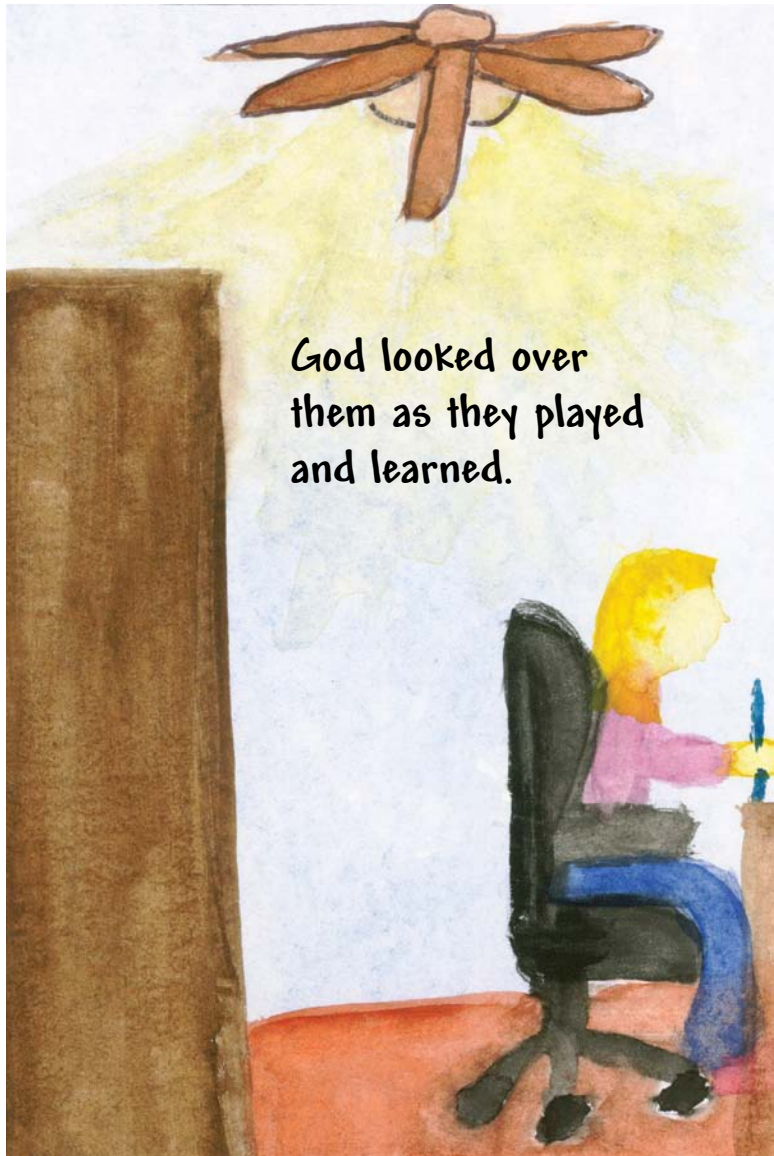




Jillian was so precious!



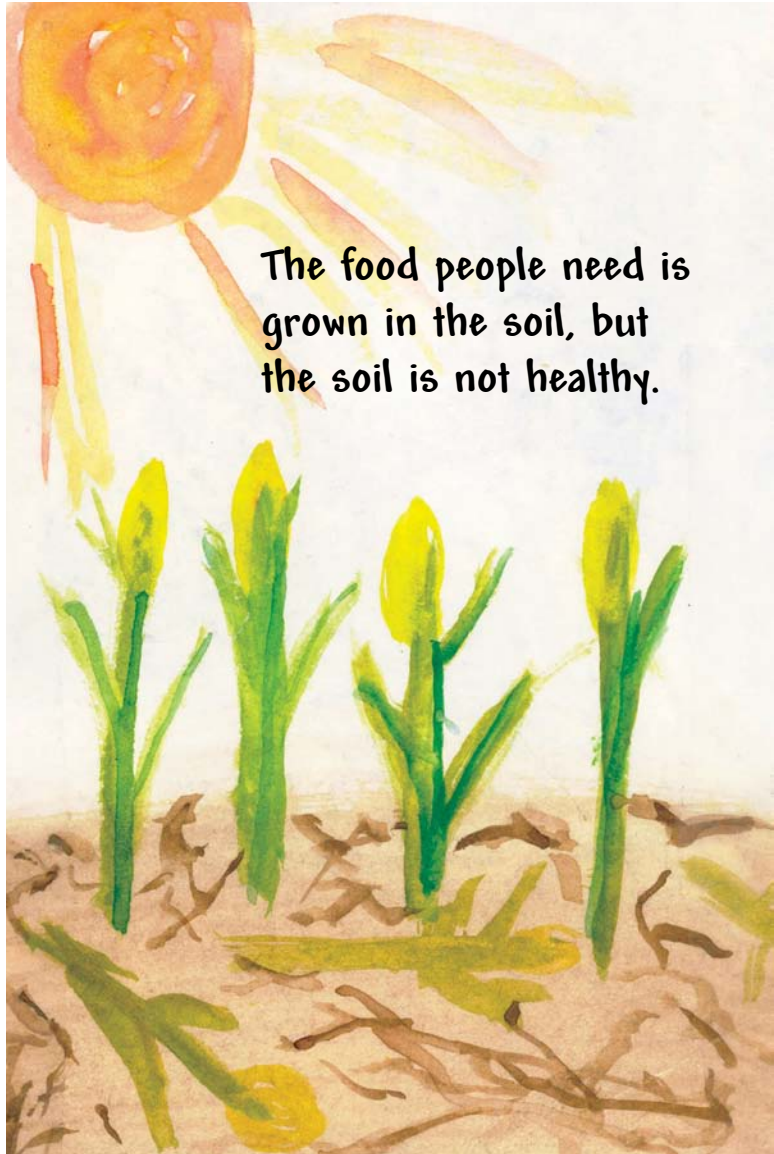
Both girls grew with the

and learned.


The island of Haiti is

hunger and suffering.






The food people need is

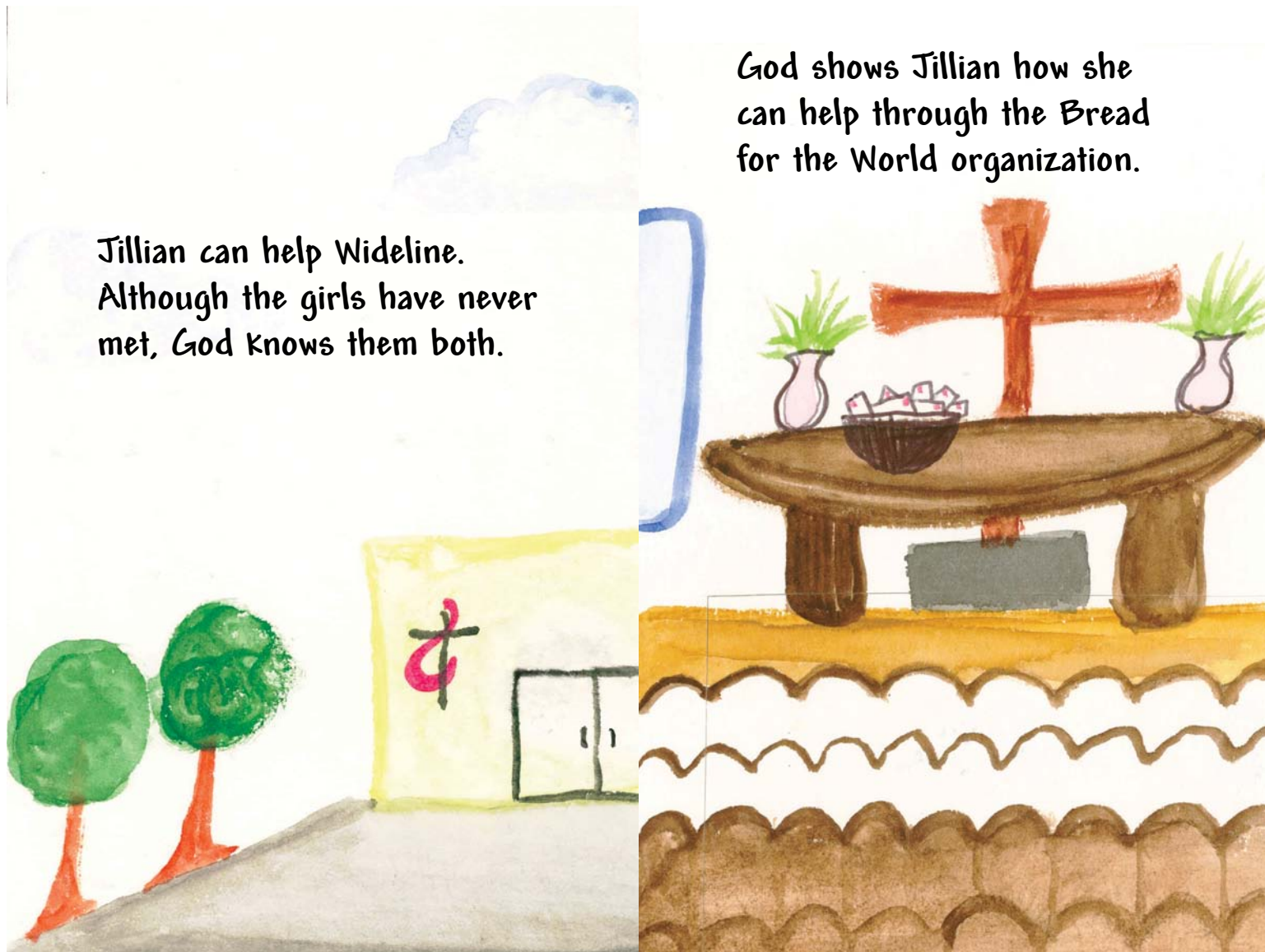

met, God knows them both.

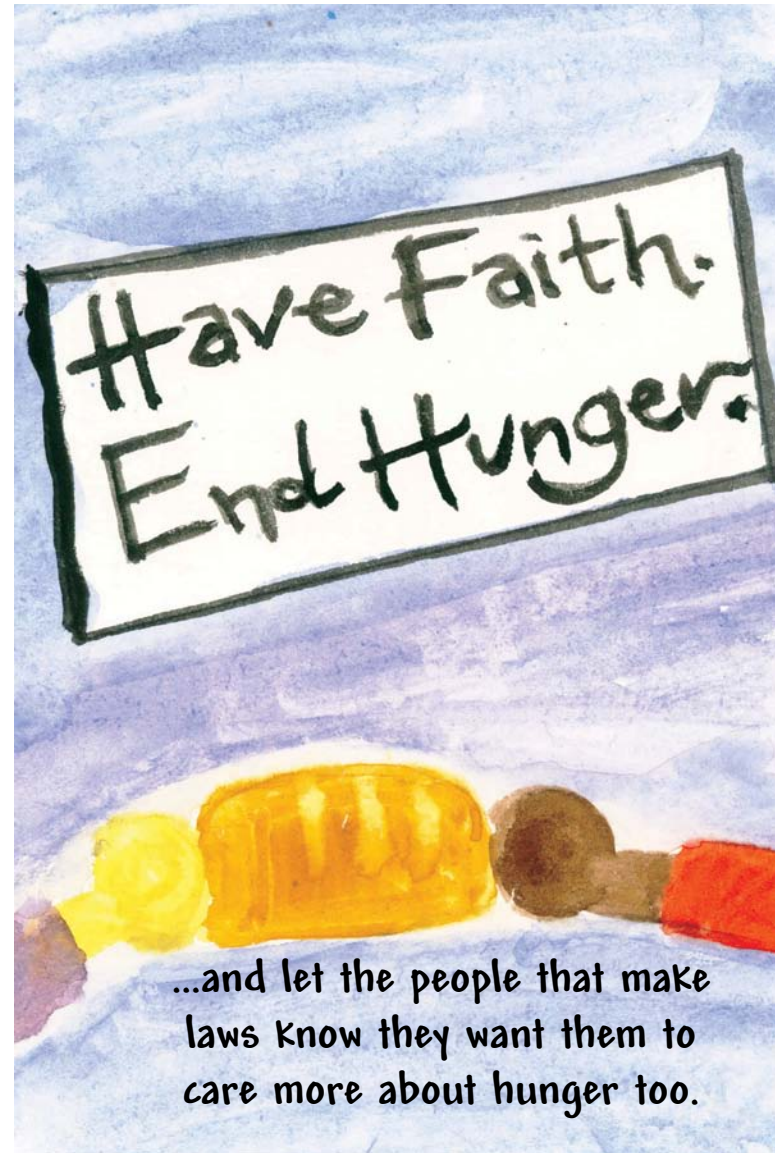
God shows Jillian how she
